Here are some updates for next week:

## Camp Chaperone Information

## Luggage Drop-Off

On Tuesday, luggage needs to be dropped off and placed by the sidewalk in front of the MPR by **7:45 AM**- before morning drop-off traffic begins. Once you have dropped off your luggage, please clear the area to allow for more luggage. *If it is raining, luggage will be dropped off inside the MPR.*

## Luggage/Packing Reminders

Please be sure to pack all the items listed on the packing list, including clothing that can be layered to accommodate varying temperatures. Additionally, please note the following:

- Place pillow in a plastic bag labeled with your child's name (they will get very dirty if left out in open)
- Please label ALL bags and items with your child's name- duct tape works great for bags
- Pack a gallon size bag filled with an extra pair of socks, pants, and undergarments. Label this bag with your child's name and BEACH DAY
- Pack a plastic sandwich-sized container for day hike lunches
- Pack a backpack to take on hikes- backpacks can come on the bus with your child
