## Notes and Reminders

### SURPRISE Letters to Your Child at WOLF Camp

There is a manila envelope in the office marked *ROOKS* where you can deposit letters that I will deliver to your child while they are away. **Please write one letter for each day (Tuesday - Thursday) and write your child's full name and the day you want them to open the letter on each envelope (ex: Joyce Rooks - Tuesday).** My hope is that each Resilient Turtle has a letter to open each night! **Please submit all letters by March 11th.**

### Camp Chaperone Information

On Friday (tomorrow), I will send home a chaperone notification form, which will have your student's cabin chaperone listed. The chaperone's phone number is listed, but please know this number is for emergencies only. Please do not call or text the chaperones; especially during camp.

### Tuesday

Students need to be dressed in proper clothing for hiking and outdoor activities on the morning of departure and bring a **BAG LUNCH!** The first meal provided by camp is dinner.

### Luggage Drop-Off

On Tuesday, luggage needs to be dropped off and placed by the sidewalk on Charbray Street by 7:45 AM- before morning drop-off traffic begins. Please look for signage and place luggage only in the designated area.

If it is raining, luggage will be dropped off in the MPR.

### **Luggage/Packing Reminders**

Please be sure to pack all the items listed on the packing list. Another copy of this list has been attached to this email. Additionally, please note the following:

- Place a pillow in a plastic bag labeled with your child's name (they will get very dirty if left out in open)
- Please label ALL bags and items being sent- duct tape works well
- Pack a gallon size bag filled with an extra pair of socks, pants, and undergarments. Label this bag with your child's name and BEACH DAY (for our last daily excursion to the beach)
- Pack a plastic sandwich-sized container (such as GLAD) for day hike lunches
- Pack a backpack to take on hikes. Backpacks can come on the bus with your student.
- NO ELECTRONICS are allowed!
